

Group Supervision & Reflective Practice for Eco-active / Eco-engaged coaches with Andra Morosi

More and more coaches are supporting clients engaged in the ecological transitions, whether on a personal or professional level. The systemic dimensions of this type of work and the various levels of complexity involved require specific attention, mindful presence and a deeper enquiry of how we as coaches show up, how vigilant we are with the ethical boundaries of our profession and how we attend to the potential edge effects.

After over two years of being an active member of the Climate Coaching Alliance and the founder of the CCA French-speaking community of eco-active coaches, as well as a member of the GSN (Global Supervisors Network) Climate sub-group, Andra is opening two group supervision spaces, one English-speaking and one French-speaking this autumn. A blend of topics, professional enquiries, client cases and resources, including nature-inspired models will be hosted in a resonant, heartfelt and embodied supervision format in the CSA style. The work will be eclectic in approach, drawing on a wide variety of frameworks and resources.

Groups are structured to have monthly 90 mins meetings for a minimum of 6 months. The dates and times are determined with the group after the first session planned on September 30th. Each group is open to minimum 4 and maximum 6 participants.

Andra is located in Normandy, France and completed the CSA Supervision Diploma in 2018; she is a tutor on both English-speaking and French-speaking CSA programmes.
